

February Meeting 3 Agenda questions

Are you happy in school?
Yes- some pupils are finding it annoying when other pupils are continuing to say 6/7 Things that make them happy in school include social learning, football and the trampolines.
Do you feel safe in school?
Mostly yes- all the time in school. Some pupils raised that they felt worried about the behaviour and disruption of a key pupil in other lessons, but did not feel unsafe.
Is there anywhere in school that you do not feel safe? Why? Who have you told?
No- most Some said that they can feel worried in the sports hall at lunch time when there is a social learning club with footballs as there are a few ball games at once. Some said that the dinner hall was too busy. It was explained that they are able to access other quieter spaces to eat lunch.
Have you been bullied? How did the school deal with it?
No Some pupils said that they had in a previous year, but not this academic year

Issues to be addressed this term

Issue	Actions to be taken- by who?	Information to be shared (following actions)
Pupils wanted the football goals to be fixed.	Toby/ Ian	New football goals are now purchased.

Previous issue now actioned- Pupils now have further equipment installed on the field. Feedback from pupils in Term 4 is positive.

Issues raised, not to be addressed as agreed by school council

- Pupils would like a school pet.
- Pupils in the adventurer classes would like more swimming opportunities- it was explained that pupils who needed more support to be able to swim 25m would have the opportunity to access swimming as an intervention.
- Pupils would like there to be a variation of school dinners- it was explained that there was already a meat/ vegetarian option, in addition to paninis, jacket potatoes and sandwiches.

Other actions -

- It was explained to the pupils that there would be interviews for the potential new headteacher happening next week and that it was important for the school council to be involved.
