<b>Are you happy in school?</b>

<b>Is there anywhere in school that you do not feel safe? Why? Who have you told?</b>

**Possible issues to be addressed in future terms**

- Pupils would like a school mascot.
- Review the rules about kindness at breaktime and ensure that they are consistent and shared.
- Children want to get in touch with another outside of school and want to find ways that their families can enable this.
- Pupils would like a wider range of side dishes.
- More opportunities to play games in class- group games.
