Are you happy in school?

Do you feel safe in school?
Yes One pupil said that they did not feel safe where they were working in RWI- following a discussion with the pupil, this has now been changed and an alternative working space has been used.
Is there anywhere in school that you do not feel safe? Why? Who have you told?
Some pupils said that they found it difficult being in the sports hall at lunchtime when it is football club because they were worried about the footballs- there are alternative clubs that pupils are able to access if they want to find an alternative space. In one class, one pupil identified younger pupils as making them feel worried because they feel that they are unpredictable.
Have you been bullied? How did the school deal with it?
Most children said no, some pupils said yes however it had been dealt with by the adults. Pupils said that in some cases members of the SLT had also supported them.
